## What's it all about?

Over a period of 6 - 10 days, the young people will generate an idea for a music video, film it and edit it together using professional equipment. The young people will learn how to script, storyboard, operate a camera and sound recording equipment and how to use Final Cut Pro. The young people will take on lead roles during the creative process and could achieve an OCN accredited qualification at the end of the course.

The course is designed to enable young people to tackle key issues that affect them such as domestic violence, drugs and alcohol abuse, sexual health etc via the production of a music video. This can either include music that the young people themselves have produced or existing music with strong issue-based lyrics.



## What's the criteria?

The music videos are part of our Big Lottery and Children In Need funded projects. As part of our funding remit, we are looking to work with groups of young aged between 13 - 19 years old from across Merseyside (Liverpool, Knowsley, St Helens, Halton, Birkenhead, Bootle and Netherton). We require between 8 and 12 participants per group and can run projects weekdays, evenings and weekends.
